Printing the object

Measuring the object by an ultrasonic sensor

Pre-treatment by plasma or primer

Printing with Piezo Drop-on-Demand Inkjet
in single pass

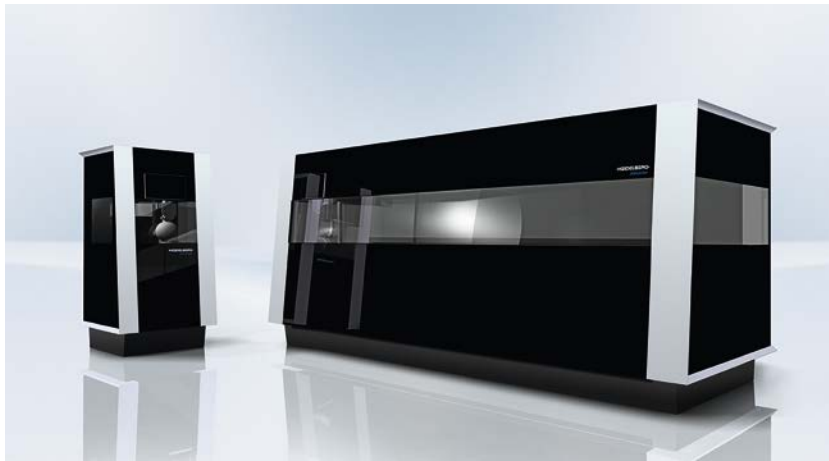

Omnifire Model Range



- Omnifire 250: 4-axis-robot system to decorate cylindrical objects with a diameter of 10 – 300 mm (launched 2015)
- Omnifire 1000: 6-axis-robot system for larger or complex objects (launch end of 2016)

Water-based inkjet system

- 1,200 × 1,200 dpi high resolution inkjet with water-based inks for **highest print quality**
- Water-based fluids
 - for **recyclable print products**
 - with Swiss Ordinance conformity for best preconditions regarding **low migration**

Multicolor technology

- Multicolor technology for **covering a huge scope of Pantone colors** by using cyan, magenta, yellow and black with gamut extenders green, orange and violet

Primefire 106 Will Address Certain Markets In The First Step Application Focus

- 170-450 gsm (coated materials 0,2 – 0,6 mm)
- 7/0 (Pantone Coverage > 95%)
- Small to ultra short runs utilizing B1 format size
- Ultra short runs to variable printing utilizing existing print shop workflows



Large format products e.g. posters, displays

- Large format (B1)
- Short runs (< 100 B1)



Die-cut products e.g. folding boxes

- Utilizing existing B1 die-cut forms
- Short runs (<1,000 B1)



Individual products e.g. chocolate box

- Utilizing special equipment and know how (e.g. food packaging)
- Prolong seasonal business with individual products
- Ultra short runs



“Sorted” products e.g. Calendar

- Sorted delivery
- Short runs (< 200 calendar B2)
